GIDE Muriel E. Gilman Memorial Scholarship

**DEADLINE: April 15, 2022** 

An academic scholarship of \$2,500 per year toward a four-year degree to a graduating female senior of a Delaware high school who is/was a participant in a GIDE program. For the 2022 scholarship, we chose to relax this participation requirement, although participation would be preferred.

#### Requirements:

- Completed application form
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers, advisors, or counselors
- SAT or ACT scores (if taken)
- The winner will commit to at least 30 hours of volunteer service at Girls Inc of Delaware (summer camp, after school) during the summer of 2022.
- The student must show continued full-time enrollment in good standing (GPA > 2.0) to receive future funding.

The GIDE Scholarship Committee will choose scholarship recipients through an objective, competitive process based on the following criteria:

- Involvement in school activities over the four years
- Volunteer activities
- Awards and honors received
- Strength of recommendation regarding the applicant's activities and leadership recorded in school, personal traits, character, and initiative.
- Career plans consistent with the undergraduate course of study
- Participation in Girl's Inc of Delaware programs.

### GIDE Dr. Zenaida Otero-Gephardt Scholarship

**DEADLINE: April 15, 2022** 

An academic scholarship of \$2,500 per year toward a four-year degree to a graduating female senior of a Delaware high school who will pursue a degree in science, technology, engineering, math, or education. Preference will be given to applicants who have participated in a past GIDE program.

#### **Requirements:**

- Completed application form
- Two letters of recommendation from teachers, advisors, or counselors
- SAT or ACT scores (if taken)
- The winner will commit to at least 30 hours of volunteer service at Girls Inc of Delaware (summer camp, after school, etc.) during the summer of 2022.
- The student must show continued full-time enrollment in good standing (GPA > 2.0) to receive future funding.

The GIDE Scholarship Committee will choose scholarship recipients through an objective, competitive process based on the following criteria:

- Involvement in school activities over the four years
- Volunteer activities
- Awards and honors received
- Strength of recommendation regarding the applicant's activities and leadership record in school, personal traits, character, and initiative.

### GIDE Clarice E. Wolf Memorial Scholarship

**DEADLINE: April 15, 2022** 

An academic scholarship of \$2,500 toward a four-year bachelor's degree for a female senior graduating from a public school in Delaware who will pursue a degree towards a career in service (teaching, nursing, medical, psychology, social work, clergy, non-profit, etc.) and will need financial aid to attend college.

#### Requirements:

- Completed essay with the theme "Helping Other Succeed" (1,000 words)
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor, or counselor
- Summary of involvement in the community
- The winner will commit to at least 50 hours of volunteer service at Girls Inc of Delaware (summer camp, after school, etc.) during the summer of 2022.

The GIDE Scholarship Committee will choose scholarship recipients through an objective, competitive process based on the following criteria:

- Strength of essay and commitment to community service
- Involvement in school and volunteer activities during high school
- Strength of recommendation regarding the applicant's activities and leadership record in school, personal traits, character, and initiative.
- Career plans consistent with the undergraduate course of study

# GIDE Full Scholarship to Wilmington University

**APPLICATION FORM:** www.girlsincde.org/scholarship-opportunities

**DEADLINE: April 15, 2022** 

An award to a graduating female senior for a **full-tuition**, **four-year scholarship to Wilmington University**, beginning in the 2022-23 academic year. This award amount is for full undergraduate tuition and excludes books, fees, repeat courses, and living expenses. The award must be used within four years and is non-transferable.

# Requirements:

- Students must be accepted by Wilmington University for the 2022-23 academic year and meet all the University's entrance requirements at the time of admission.
- Completed essay with the theme "My Strong, Smart and Bold Life" (2,000-2,500 words)
- Documentation of grades (transcript to date, GED certificate, etc.)
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor, or counselor
- One letter of recommendation from a female mentor in your life.
- The winner will commit to at least 60 hours of volunteer service at Girls Inc of Delaware (summer camp, after school, etc.) during the summer of 2022.
- The student must maintain a minimum GPA to remain enrolled at Wilmington University and remain eligible for the scholarship.

The GIDE Scholarship Committee will choose scholarship recipients through an objective, competitive process based on the following criteria:

- Strength of essay
- Record of community service, strong academic performance, and participation in school activities.
- Strength of recommendation regarding the applicant's activities and leadership record in school, personal traits, character, and initiative.
- While not a requirement, GIDE encourages prior participants in GIDE programs to submit an application.
